



## Construction Update: Steveston Interchange Project

### Final phase of Geotechnical work starts June 26, 2022

#### June 2022

As part of the Province of B.C.'s Steveston Interchange Project, which will expand the interchange from two to five lanes, crews are completing geotechnical investigations in the project area. Geotechnical investigations involve drilling boreholes to gather important information about soil conditions. Crews will work in the areas surrounding the loop on-ramp on the east side of the interchange. This work will require a hydrovac truck and truck-mounted drill rig equipment. Work will be completed overnight to minimize traffic impacts on Highway 99.

##### Timing

- > Starting Sunday, June 26, 2022 for approximately one week



##### Hours of Work

- > Nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.



##### Traffic

- > Overnight traffic control for Highway 99 northbound lane closure
- > Flaggers and notification signs will be in place to direct traffic



##### Impacts/Interruptions

- > Noise impacts will be minimal and similar to existing traffic noise levels
