





Construction Update: Steveston Interchange Project

Geotechnical Investigation Work Starting June 6th, 2022

June 2022

As part of the Province of B.C.'s Steveston Interchange Project, which will expand the interchange from two to five lanes, crews will continue geotechnical investigations in the project area. Geotechnical investigations involve drilling boreholes to gather important information about soil conditions. Crews will work in the areas surrounding the Highway 99 southbound HOV/bus lane, Highway 99 eastbound to northbound on-ramp, and near the bridge approaches on Steveston Highway. This work will require a hydrovac truck and track-mounted drill rig equipment. Work will be completed overnight to minimize traffic impacts on Highway 99 and Steveston Highway.

What to Expect



Timing

 Starting the week of June 6th for approximately two weeks



Hours of Work

Nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.



Traffic

Starting the week of June 6th, the following work will occur:

- Right turn lane closure on the Highway 99 northbound off-ramp (near Richmond Country Farms)
- > Highway 99 northbound lane closure
- Highway 99 southbound HOV bus lane closure (buses will reroute around the work area)
- Single lane alternating traffic on Steveston Highway
- Flaggers and notification signs will be in place to direct traffic



Impacts/Interruptions

- Noise impacts will be minimal and similar to existing traffic noise levels
- Minor traffic delays on Steveston Highway
