

Canadian Navigable Waters Act

Transportation Investment Corporation hereby gives notice that an application has been made to the federal Minister of Transport, pursuant to the Government of Canada's *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* for approval of the work described herein and its site and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 7(2) of the said Act, Transportation Investment Corporation has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the online Navigable Waters Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) under the **NPP File Number 2022-506653** a description of the following work, its site and plans:

Fraser River Tunnel Project – Investigatory Works – Geotechnical and Dredge

in, on, over, under, through or across:

Fraser River, South Arm

at:

300 metres upstream from the George Massey Tunnel at the channel midline.
