



Construction Update: Steveston Interchange Project

Utilities investigation starts on August 4, 2022

August 2022

As part of the Province of B.C.'s Steveston Interchange Project, which will expand the interchange from two to five lanes, crews will be performing utilities investigation in the project area. This work involves using a hydrovac truck to remove the asphalt and soil to locate utilities. Crews will work in the shoulder area of eastbound Steveston Highway by Richmond Country Farms. Work will be completed overnight to minimize traffic impacts on Highway 99.

Timing

- > August 4-5, 2022 and August 8, 2022



Hours of Work

- > Nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.



Traffic

- > Overnight traffic control for Highway 99 northbound off-ramp lane closure
- > Flagger and notification signs will be in place to direct traffic



Impacts/Interruptions

- > Noise impacts will be minimal and similar to existing traffic noise levels
