





Construction Update: Steveston Interchange Project

Soil sampling and electrical work

August 2022

As part of the Province of B.C.'s Steveston Interchange Project, which will expand the interchange from two to five lanes, crews will perform soil sampling and electrical work.

Soil sampling is necessary to understand the existing ground conditions in preparation for construction. This activity will take place during the day in the southeast and northeast quadrants of the interchange and will begin in late August or early September. Drill equipment will be used. Traffic impacts are not anticipated, and noise impacts will be minimal.

The Project is also doing some electrical work, which will require a vehicle to be parked on the grassy area of the southwest quadrant of the interchange. This work will be performed at night, and no traffic or noise impacts are anticipated.
