

Construction Update: Steveston Interchange Project

Update on site preparations

February 2023

This notice is an update to: Construction Update: Steveston Interchange Project Site preparations for upcoming construction – issued November 1, 2022.

On February 13, crews will begin tree removal for construction of the Steveston Interchange Project. The work will take place on the east and west sides of the interchange along Steveston Highway and last about three weeks. This is necessary to accommodate the footprint of the larger interchange and to clear the area for construction. Larger trees and shrubs that are removed will be replaced.

Work will take place during the night to avoid lane closures on Highway 99 during peak hours. The highway will remain open, during night hours, with intermittent lane closures expected. Access for emergency responders, residents and businesses will be maintained throughout construction.
