

Project Update: October 2023

Tunnel Project Advances to Next Stage of Procurement

Following a successful Request for Qualifications, the Province announced on October 18, 2023 a shortlist of teams that will move forward to the Request for Proposals (RFP) phase of procurement for the Fraser River Tunnel Project to replace the George Massey Tunnel.

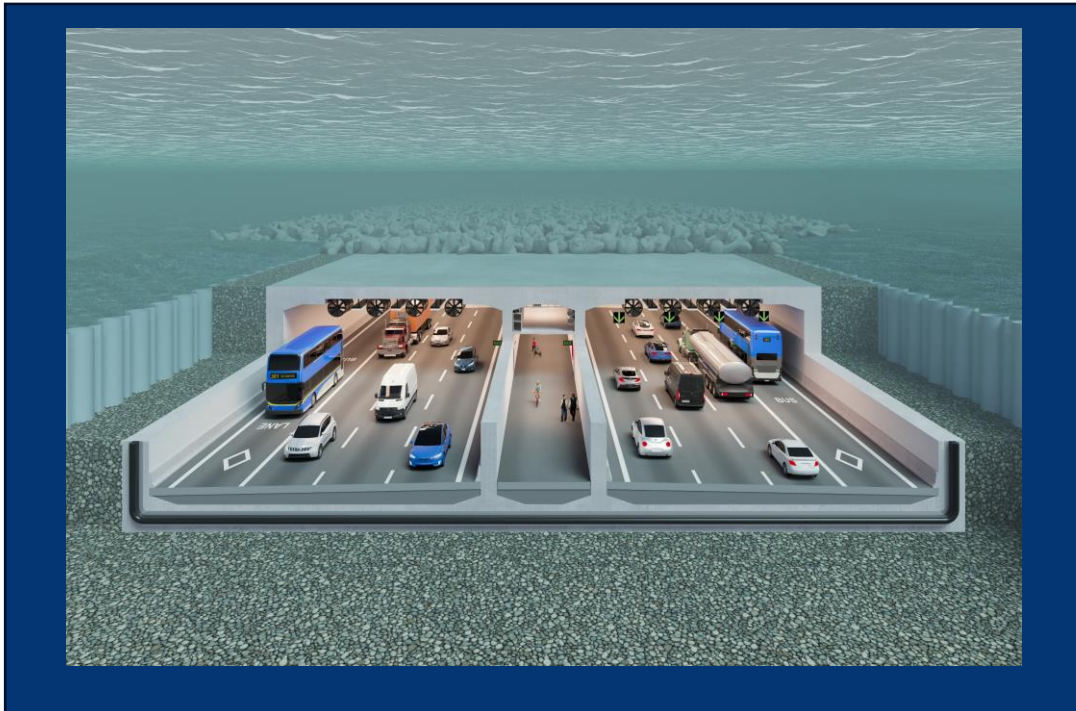

These proponents will spend the next several months working on their RFP submissions, which will be carefully evaluated before one team is selected to begin design of the Fraser River Tunnel Project next spring.

The Project is being procured through a Progressive Design-Build with Target Price model. One of the many benefits to this procurement model is that it allows design to progress concurrently with the Project's environmental assessment.

Once completed, the new eight-lane, toll-free tunnel will provide safer and more efficient travel across the Fraser River. The tunnel will include three general-purpose lanes and a dedicated transit lane in each direction. Whether you're on a local bus or bus rapid transit, your trip will be quick and reliable. It will also provide an active-transportation corridor for pedestrians and cyclists for the first time at this crossing.
