As the Fraser River Tunnel Project progresses through the Environmental Assessment, there are several opportunities for the public to learn about the Project and provide feedback. Please join us at one of the open houses listed below.

After successfully completing the Early Engagement phase of the Environmental Assessment, the Project received a positive Readiness Decision on September 14, 2023, and is now in the Process Planning phase. This phase will determine how the Environmental Assessment (EA) is carried out, including:

- What information must be provided
- How the information will be gathered
- How people will be engaged and involved in the EA

Input provided will help ensure the delivery of the Project meets the needs of communities during construction and well into the future.

Once completed, the new eight-lane, toll-free tunnel will provide safer and more efficient travel across the Fraser River. The tunnel will include three general-purpose lanes and a dedicated transit lane in each direction. Whether you're on a local bus or bus rapid transit,

your trip will be quick and reliable. It will also provide an active-transportation corridor for pedestrians and cyclists for the first time at this crossing.
