


Construction Update: Steveston Interchange Project

Traffic Impacts for Pier Piling

October 2023

Note: this notice has been updated to include impacts to transit users



Starting on November 14, there will be new traffic impacts on Steveston Highway and Highway 99 for approximately two months while pier piling is completed as part of the Steveston Interchange Project.

Steveston Highway: there will be a full closure of the northbound loop onramp to Highway 99 for vehicles traveling eastbound on Steveston Highway starting November 14 for two months. Vehicles will instead enter Highway 99 by turning left from Steveston Highway onto the existing northbound on-ramp. The intersection will be temporarily upgraded to accommodate two left-turning lanes during the closure. Motorists are encouraged to consider alternative routes. Some interruptions and brief delays may occur for transit users.

Highway 99: there will be a full closure of the southbound bus-only lane on Highway 99 starting November 14 for two months. Buses will reroute via the southbound off-ramp and will maintain service to the Highway 99 southbound transit stop via the transit-only onramp.

Pier piling will only take place during the day. Nearby residents and pedestrians will hear noise and feel vibrations in the immediate area where work is taking place. For added safety, there will be intermittent stoppages for pedestrians crossing the Steveston Highway overpass sidewalk.

	<p>Traffic</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> > Full closure of the northbound loop ramp onto Highway 99 > Closure of the southbound bus lane on Highway 99 > Pedestrian stoppages on the side of the Steveston Highway overpass > Flaggers and notification signs will be in place > Drivers are encouraged to use alternate routes when possible 		<p>Impacts/Interruptions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> > Noise and vibration in the immediate area will occur during pier piling > Noise and dust from construction equipment > Transit users may need to plan for additional travel time to reach bus stops
