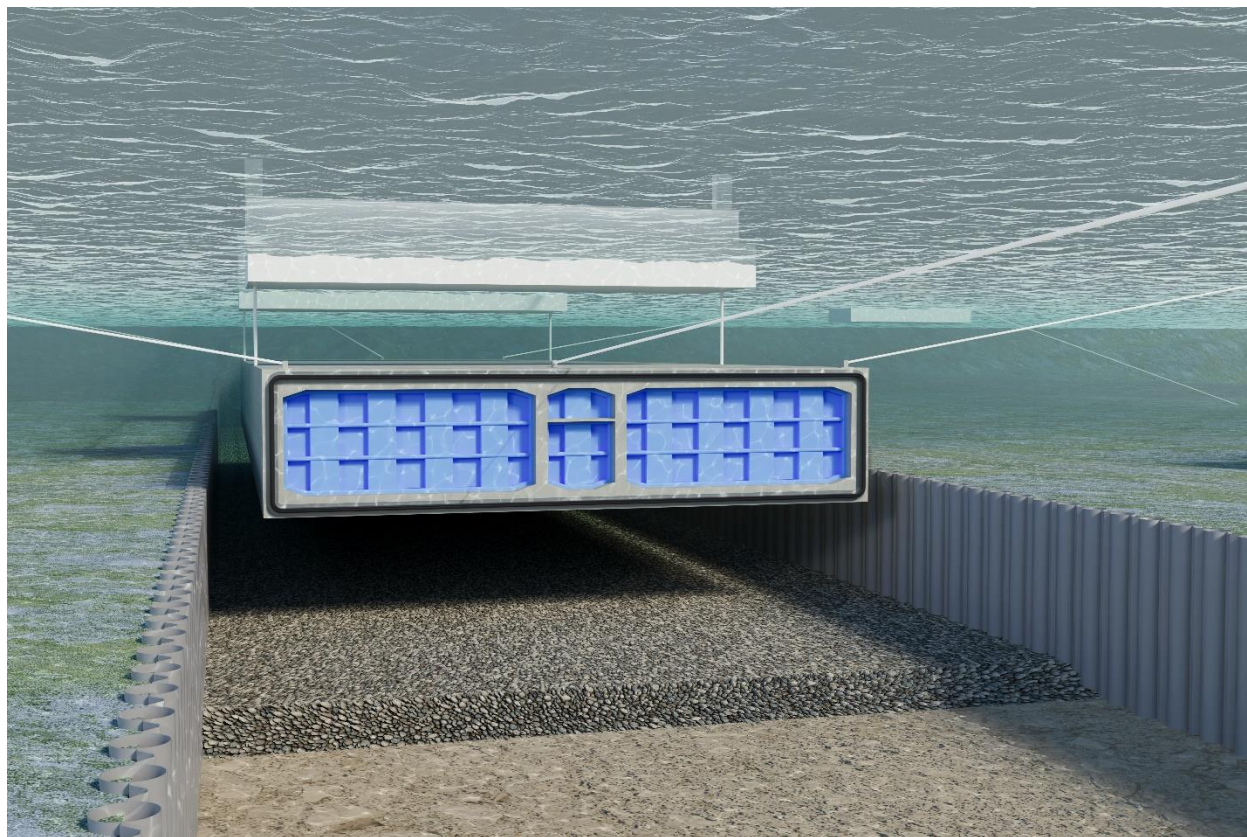


## Project Update: January 2024

---

### Building the New Eight-Lane Tunnel



The Fraser River Tunnel Project involves immersing six tunnel elements under the Fraser River to create a new eight-lane tunnel along Highway 99. It will be located about 40 metres upstream of the existing George Massey Tunnel. When completed, the new toll-free tunnel will provide more capacity for drivers and transit users in both directions, while providing people with a walking and cycling option between Richmond and Delta.

## About the Program

As part of the Highway 99 Tunnel Program, the Province is delivering five projects over the next several years to improve travel along the corridor. In keeping with regional priorities, the projects include transit improvements and the crossing's first walking and cycling path. The Program consists of three transit and cycling projects completed in 2023, and the new Steveston Interchange, which is scheduled to open in 2025. The new eight-lane, toll-free tunnel will open 2030.
