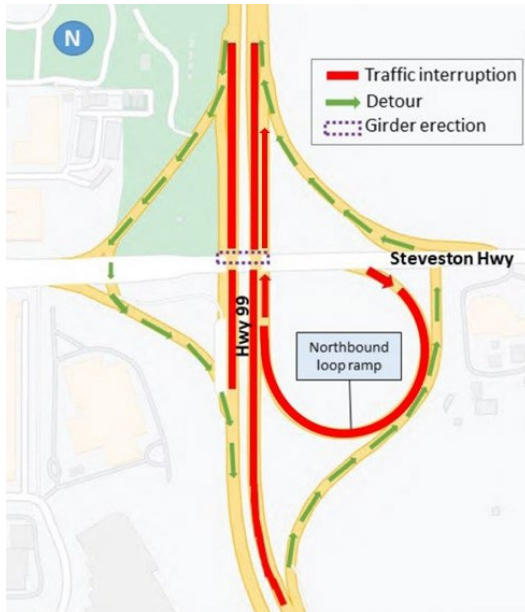


Steveston Interchange Project

Traffic Impact: Full Overnight Highway 99 Closures Beginning June 14, 2024

Updated: June 13, 2024



Highway 99 northbound and southbound will be closed to traffic for two consecutive nights beginning Friday, June 14 and concluding Sunday, June 16. To minimize traffic disruptions, work will only occur between 11 p.m. and 4:30 a.m.

The closure is necessary for the erection of the main concrete girders that will span Highway 99 and form the first section of the new five-lane Steveston Interchange, as part of the Highway 99 Tunnel Program.

Vehicles travelling on Highway 99 will be detoured using the on- and off-ramps at Steveston Highway. The Steveston Highway northbound loop ramp onto Highway 99 will be closed and traffic rerouted to access the north side on-ramp.

East-west travel on Steveston Highway will be maintained for vehicles, pedestrians, and cyclists. Existing transit stops will be maintained in all directions.

A second closure will be required to install additional girders in July. An update will be provided with the specific dates of the second closure.

- > Eastbound traffic on Steveston Highway to Highway 99 northbound will be rerouted on site

- > Expect minor delays
- > Moderate noise from construction equipment
