





Steveston Interchange Project

Northbound Off-Ramp Lane Closures for Drainage Work

March 2025

Ground improvement and drainage activities are currently in progress as we move forward with Phase 2 construction of the new five-lane Steveston Interchange.



Starting Monday, March 31, 2025 and lasting for approximately two weeks, crews will require nightly lane closures on the northbound off-ramp to accommodate drainage work.

At least one lane will remain open on the ramp at all times, existing turning movements will be maintained, and signage will be in place to direct traffic. No significant traffic delays are expected.

There will be no impact to the bus stop on the east side of the off-ramp.

The work will be conducted overnight to minimize traffic impacts.

Drivers are reminded that while Phase 2 of the Steveston Interchange Project is under construction, the northbound loop ramp will be closed with a two-lane left turn signal onto the northside ramp detour in place.
