






Steveston Interchange Project

Overnight Single-Lane Alternating Traffic on Steveston Highway

March-April 2025

Ground improvements and roadwork are getting underway as Phase 2 of the Project moves forward.



Beginning Thursday, March 6, drivers can expect periodic single-lane alternating traffic on Steveston Highway overnights for approximately two months. This is required to safely conduct ground improvements and for road grading on the east side of the overpass. Drivers can expect short periods where lanes to the east of Highway 99 remain unpaved while road grading is conducted.

There will be no impacts to Highway 99 traffic.

Ground improvement work is expected to generate noise and vibrations in the direct vicinity.

The overpass sidewalk will remain open, and there will be no impact to the Highway 99 bus stop.

Every effort will be made to minimize delays, while this work is completed. Please follow road signs and direction from traffic crews.

Drivers are reminded that while Phase 2 of the Steveston Interchange Project is under construction, the northbound loop ramp will be closed with a left turn signal onto the northside ramp detour in place.
