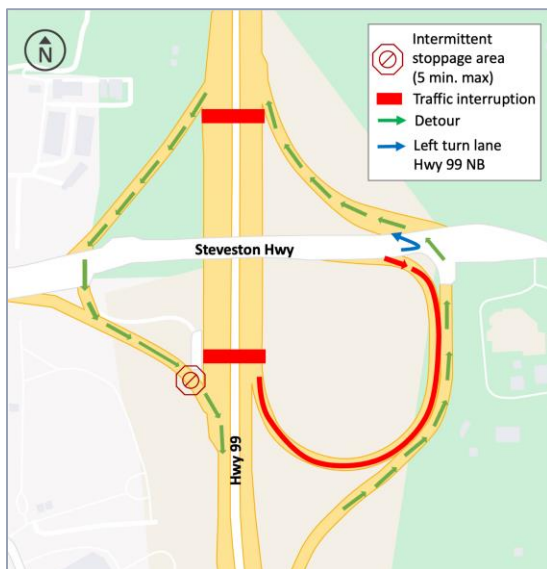


Steveston Interchange Project

Overnight Highway 99 Closures for Concrete Girder Delivery and Installation

July 2025

Update: Work to install the Phase 2 main-span girders has been completed **ahead of schedule**, and the traffic pattern changes indicated below will no longer be required on the week of **July 21**.



As work progresses on Phase 2 of the new, five-lane Steveston Interchange, the delivery and installation of the main concrete girders that will span Highway 99 is scheduled to begin **as early as July 18**. This will require the **closure of Highway 99 for approximately 8 consecutive nights**.

To minimize traffic interruptions, work will only take place during the following times:

- **July 18 - 19: 10 P.M. to 7 A.M.**
- **July 20 - 25: 10 P.M. to 4:30 A.M.**

Vehicles travelling on Highway 99 will be detoured using the on- and off-ramps at Steveston Highway.

Intermittent traffic stoppages on the southbound Highway 99 on-ramp will be necessary to allow the girders to be transported into position. On-ramp stoppages will be kept to a maximum of five minutes.

As is currently the case, the Steveston Highway northbound loop ramp onto Highway 99 will remain closed, with traffic rerouted to access the north side on-ramp via left turn lanes.

East-west travel on Steveston Highway will be maintained for vehicles, pedestrians, and cyclists. Existing transit stops will be maintained in all directions.

The new five-lane Steveston Interchange Project is a key part of the Highway 99 Tunnel Program to improve travel along the Highway 99 corridor. As part of the broader Program, the interchange will integrate seamlessly with the new eight-lane, immersed tube tunnel being built under the Fraser River to replace the George Massey Tunnel.
