

Fraser River Tunnel Project

Highway 99 Overnight Lane Closures

August 2025

As part of the Fraser River Tunnel Project to replace the George Massey Tunnel with a new eight-lane, toll-free tunnel, overnight single-lane closures will take place within the tunnel to allow crews to safely complete a pre-condition assessment ahead of geotechnical work planned on Deas Island in August.

- To minimize traffic disruptions, closures will take place from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- One lane will be closed per night - travel in both directions will be maintained at all times.
- Lane closures will be well signed and traffic-control personnel will be on-site.

What to Expect

Timing > Overnight on August 5, 6, 7, and 10	Hours of Work > 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
Traffic > One lane will be closed per night	Impacts/Interruptions > Drivers may experience minor delays
