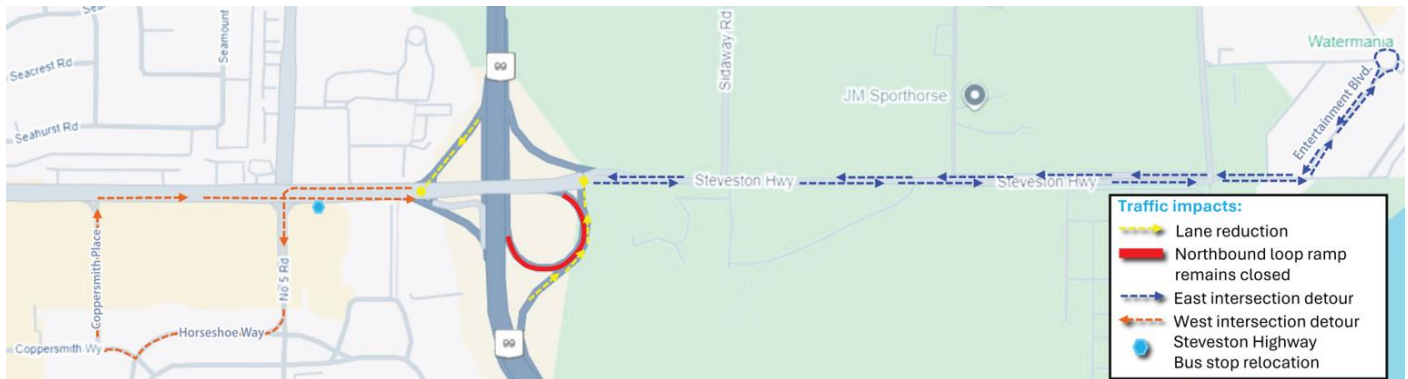


## Steveston Interchange Project

**Overnight lane closures for Highway 99 off-ramps and Steveston Highway beginning August 10**

**August 2025**



As work progresses on Phase 2 of the new five-lane Steveston Interchange Project, road construction will be taking place at the eastern and western intersections of Steveston Highway for **approximately one month, beginning as early as August 10.**

Overnight, Highway 99 ramp lane closures and traffic pattern shifts on Steveston Highway are expected **between 9:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.**

For approximately the first two weeks, construction will occur at the western intersection. During this time, left turns will be restricted, and drivers will need to follow the designated detour route.

During this period, the eastbound bus stop on the south side of Steveston Highway will be temporarily relocated approximately 200 metres to the west.

In the final weeks of the work, construction will shift to the eastern intersection. Left turns will again be restricted, with detours in place for drivers.

During construction, road users should expect periods of uneven road surfaces. Buses will follow the detour route when required. As is currently the case, the Steveston Highway northbound loop ramp onto Highway 99 will remain closed.

East-west travel on Steveston Highway will be maintained for vehicles, pedestrians, and cyclists.

## What to Expect



### Timing

- > Approximately a month, beginning as early as August 10



### Hours of Work

- > 9:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.



### Traffic

- > Lane closures on Highway 99 on- and off-ramps
- > West and east intersections: periods when detour in effect for left turn movements
- > Northbound loop ramp remains closed



### Impacts/Interruptions

- > Expect some delays, plan for additional travel time
- > Buses to follow detour routes
- > Steveston Highway eastbound bus stop temporarily relocated approximately 200 metres west
