Highway 99 Overnight Lane Closures

Intermittent Closures Until February 2026 for Geotechnical Investigations

As part of the Fraser River Tunnel Project to replace the George Massey Tunnel with a new eight-lane, toll-free tunnel, intermittent overnight lane closures will occur within the tunnel until February 2026. This is necessary to complete ongoing geotechnical investigations.

- To minimize traffic disruptions, closures will take place from:
 - **Monday – Friday:** 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. (northbound) or 6 a.m. (southbound)
 - **Saturday:** 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Travel in both directions will be maintained at all times.
- Lane closures will be well signed and traffic-control personnel will be on-site.

What to Expect

Timing > Overnight, intermittently until February 2026 (watch for signage) > Specific dates may be shared ahead of closures at Highway99Tunnel.ca/FRT-Current-Work	Hours of Work > Monday – Friday: 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. (northbound) or 6 a.m. (southbound) > Saturday: 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.
Traffic > Travel in both directions will be maintained	Impacts/Interruptions > Drivers may experience minor delays
