





Steveston Interchange Project

Overnight Single Lane Alternating Traffic on Steveston Highway

September 2025



Starting as early as **Tuesday, September 23,** single-lane alternating traffic will be in effect on Steveston Highway for one night between 11 p.m. and 4.30 a.m.

This temporary traffic pattern change is necessary to ensure the safe and efficient completion of scheduled inspection work.

The Steveston Highway overpass sidewalk will remain open. There will be no impact on transit stops.

Every effort will be made to minimize delays while this work is completed. Please follow road signs and directions from traffic crews.

As is currently the case, the Steveston Highway northbound loop ramp onto Highway 99 will

remain closed, with traffic rerouted to access the north side on-ramp via left turn lanes.

The new five-lane Steveston Interchange Project is a key part of the Highway 99 Tunnel Program to improve travel along the Highway 99 corridor. As part of the broader Program, the interchange will integrate seamlessly with the new eight-lane, immersed tube tunnel being built under the Fraser River to replace the George Massey Tunnel.
