





Steveston Interchange Project Upcoming Highway 99 Overnight Closures

October 2025



As work progresses toward completion on the new five-lane Steveston Interchange Project, Highway 99 will be closed to overnight traffic for **approximately two nights beginning as early as October 1.**

The traffic pattern change is to allow crews to safely remove temporary supports from the new Phase 2 structure.

Closures will take place between **11 p.m. and 4:30 a.m.** Vehicles travelling on Highway 99 will be detoured using the on- and off-ramps at Steveston Highway.

As is currently the case, the Steveston Highway northbound loop ramp onto Highway 99 will remain closed, with traffic rerouted to access the north side on-ramp via left turn lanes.

The work is being completed overnight to minimize daytime traffic disruptions.

The new five-lane Steveston Interchange Project is a key part of the Highway 99 Tunnel Program to improve travel along the Highway 99 corridor. As part of the broader Program, the interchange will integrate seamlessly with the new eight-lane, immersed tube tunnel being built under the Fraser River to replace the George Massey Tunnel.

Traffic

- > Traffic detour utilizing onand off-ramps
- Left turn signal onto the northside ramp detour remains in place



Impacts/Interruptions

- > Expect minor delays
- Moderate noise from construction equipment
