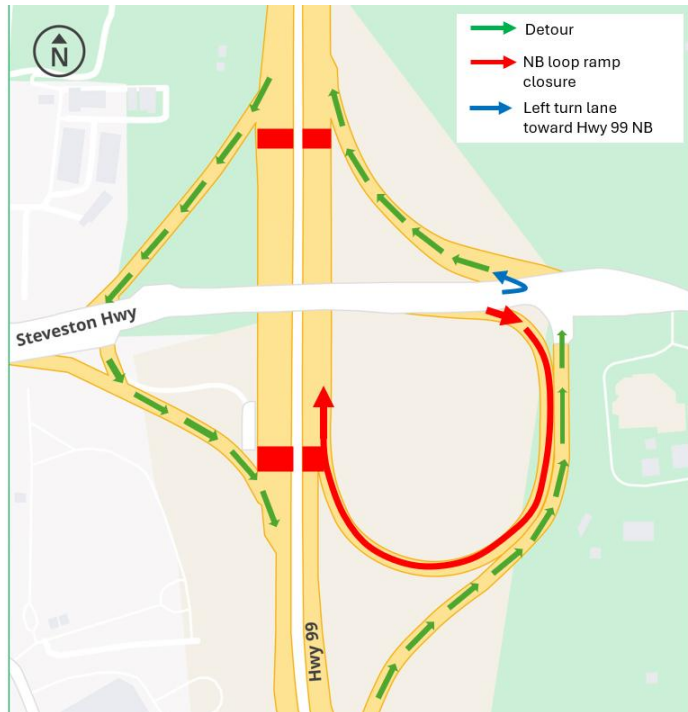


Steveston Interchange Project

Highway 99 Resurfacing: Overnight Traffic Pattern Changes

September 2025

Updated September 17: The overnight southbound detour will use the on- and off-ramps, instead of the bus lane.



As work progresses toward completion of the Steveston Interchange Project, overnight changes to traffic patterns on Highway 99 will be required for road resurfacing.

Beginning as early as September 15, work will take place nightly between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. for approximately two weeks.

Northbound and southbound traffic can expect periods of rerouting via the on- and off-ramps. Closures will happen one direction at a time. Clear signage will be in place to direct traffic safely through these detours.

As is currently the case, the Steveston Highway northbound loop ramp onto Highway 99 will remain closed, with traffic rerouted to access the north side on-ramp via left turn lanes.

East-west travel on Steveston Highway will be maintained for vehicles, pedestrians, and cyclists. Existing transit stops will be maintained in all directions.

The new five-lane Steveston Interchange Project is a key component of the Highway 99 Tunnel Program to improve travel along the Highway 99 corridor. As part of the broader Program, the interchange will integrate seamlessly with the new eight-lane, immersed tube tunnel being built under the Fraser River to replace the George Massey Tunnel.
