





Fraser River Tunnel Project DAILY NAVIGATION NOTIFICATION

October 23, 2025

This Daily Notification provides an update on the status of geotechnical investigation works for the Fraser River Tunnel Project. These daily updates are a supplement to the weekly NAVWARN which should be referred to for further details of the project.

Today's activities include transiting equipment to the project site (In-river Test Section), located near the Canfisco property, within the Administrative Safety Zone of the Main River Navigation Channel. Refer to the figure and coordinates presented below.

Location of Activity:

Survey boat movement will generally be within the following boundary:

- 49° 7'28.19"N / 123° 4'29.81"W
- 49° 7'26.71"N / 123° 4'28.01"W
- 49° 7'23.52"N / 123° 4'33.05"W
- 49° 7'25.68"N / 123° 4'35.65"W

Initial works will include bathymetric survey, side scan sonar.
