






Steveston Interchange Project Steveston Highway Temporary Overpass Traffic Switch

November 2025



As work progresses on the Steveston Interchange Project, eastbound and westbound traffic will be shifted onto the south half of the new structure to allow for the paving of the north section.

This **temporary** traffic pattern change will begin **as early as November 27, and will remain in effect for approximately three weeks.**

During this time, pedestrian access will also be redirected to the south half of the new structure. Existing transit patterns will be maintained, with minor adjustments to bus stop locations. Signage will be in place to safely guide transit, vehicle, and pedestrian traffic.


This traffic pattern change includes the

reopening of the northbound Steveston Highway loop ramp onto Highway 99 and ending the temporary left-turn detour to the northside Highway 99 ramp.

In addition, final sidewalk, curb, and paving works will be carried out until the new overpass fully opens to the public later this fall. Minor delays are expected during this time. When possible, work will be conducted overnight to minimize traffic impacts.

The new five-lane Steveston Interchange Project is a key part of the Highway 99 Tunnel Program to improve travel along the Highway 99 corridor. As part of the broader Program, the interchange will integrate seamlessly with the new eight-lane, immersed tube tunnel being built under the Fraser River to replace the George Massey Tunnel.
