Brief Description of Work:

Deas Slough Bridge Investigations – The structural investigations consist of taking concrete and steel samples on the substructure of the Deas Slough Bridge to assess its condition and life span. Samples will be taken on the bridge North abutment, both piers and their piles, ultrasonic testing will also be performed on the piles. Steel coupon will be cut and concrete core holes will be drilled; holes will be grouted, and steel patches will be welded.

Works will be undertaken from the boat whenever possible and underwater works will be done by divers.

Works will occur during day 7am to 7pm, the vessel will be lit in accordance with the Transport Canada requirements.




Figure 1: Site Location




Figure 2: Works Location
