Additional Lanes Opening at Steveston Interchange

December 2025

Drivers can expect the following improvements at Steveston Interchange starting the morning of Tuesday, December 23, 2025:



Southbound Highway 99 off-ramp: A second dedicated right-turn lane onto Steveston Highway westbound has been added. This new dual right-turn traffic pattern will be controlled by a traffic signal.

Northbound Highway 99 off-ramp: A new secondary left-turn lane has been added.

Steveston Highway Overpass: Two westbound lanes, two eastbound lanes and a dedicated left-turn lane that spans the length of the overpass have been added for vehicles.

Sidewalks: Protected sidewalks have been added on both sides of the overpass.

These changes will immediately work to improve traffic flow and increase safety for road users.

Drivers are advised to follow new signage and signals while navigating these new traffic pattern changes.

While all vehicle lanes will be opened, work will continue through spring 2026 to complete landscaping, final paving, and site finishing activities, ensuring the project is ready for its long-term role in supporting regional travel.

We would like to thank everyone for their continued patience and understanding during the construction of the new interchange.

The new five-lane Steveston Interchange Project is a key part of the Highway 99 Tunnel Program to improve travel along the Highway 99 corridor. As part of the broader Program, the interchange will integrate seamlessly with the new eight-lane, immersed tube tunnel being built under the Fraser River to replace the George Massey Tunnel.
