Fraser River Tunnel Project: Overnight Lane Closures in the George Massey Tunnel

As part of ongoing preparations for construction of the new toll-free, eight-lane tunnel to replace the existing George Massey Tunnel, crews will conduct overnight work in the tunnel.

Starting January 11 and continuing through March, single-lane closures will be in effect overnight, so crews can carry out maintenance work.

- Nightly lane closures will be in effect for up to seven days per week:
 - **Monday – Friday:** 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. (northbound) or 6 a.m. (southbound).
 - **Saturday – Sunday:** 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Travel in both directions will be maintained at all times.
- Signs will be posted and traffic-control personnel will be on site.
