

Steveston Interchange Project

Lane Closures for Concrete Pours

January 2026







Concrete pours for the traffic median and bike lane curbs on the new Steveston Interchange Project overpass are scheduled to begin **as early as Friday, January 16.**

To safely conduct this work, periodic lane closures will be in place on Steveston Highway, with up to one lane closed in both the eastbound and westbound directions. In addition, one lane on the northbound off-ramp may also be closed at times.

Intermittent work is scheduled to take place for approximately three weeks.

The new five-lane Steveston Interchange Project is a key part of the Highway 99 Tunnel Program to improve travel along the Highway 99 corridor. As part of the broader Program, the interchange will integrate seamlessly with the new eight-lane, immersed tube tunnel being built under the Fraser River to replace the George Massey Tunnel.
