Moving Ahead with the Fraser River Tunnel Project

Tree Clearing and Replacement Strategy

As part of construction of the new toll-free, eight-lane replacement of the George Massey Tunnel, crews are preparing the Project site and creating space for the new alignment. This includes removing trees, which will be replanted once the project is completed.

Clearing will take place on Deas Island, and in Delta and Richmond, and will be completed in accordance with applicable legislation and best-management practices.

The Project team recognizes the significance of trees to the area and will work closely with Metro Vancouver, the cities of Richmond and Delta, and First Nations to restore and enhance sites within the Project area as we move ahead with this important regional transportation investment.

TREE INVENTORY, RETENTION, AND REMOVAL PLAN

A *Tree Inventory, Retention, and Removal Plan* is in place to carefully inventory all trees in the Project footprint, and document their species, size and current condition. This will help guide how trees will be managed throughout the Project.
