Brief Description of Work:




Figure 1: Navigation Detour

- Backfill operations will be conducted through the navigation channel – **A Modified South Navigation Channel Detour will be in effect (Figure 1)**

FRPD 309 will communicate with Victoria Traffic Services to ensure timely transmission of these requests during active backfilling intervals.




Figure 2: Marine Equipment Staging




Figure 4: Site Location
