Highway 99 Intermittent Overnight Lane Closures

Overnight Lane Closures Throughout February 2026

As part of early construction works for the new toll-free, eight-lane tunnel to replace the existing George Massey Tunnel, there will be intermittent overnight lane closures along Highway 99 between Westminster Highway and Highway 17 throughout February 2026.

- Intermittent work will occur overnight.
- Travel in both directions will be maintained at all times.
- Lane closures will be well signed, and traffic-control personnel will be on site as needed.

What to Expect

Timing > Intermittently throughout February 2026 (watch for signage)	Hours of Work > Monday – Friday: 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. (northbound) or 6 a.m. (southbound) > Saturday – Sunday: 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.
Traffic > Travel in both directions will be maintained	Impacts/Interruptions > Drivers may experience minor delays
