### Highway 99 Intermittent Overnight Lane Closures

Updated February 27, 2026: The overnight lane closures will extend into early March.

#### Overnight Lane Closures Throughout February and early March 2026

As part of early construction works for the new toll-free, eight-lane tunnel to replace the existing George Massey Tunnel, there will be intermittent overnight lane closures along Highway 99 between Westminster Highway and Highway 17 throughout February and early March 2026.

- Intermittent work will occur overnight.
- Travel in both directions will be maintained at all times.
- Lane closures will be well signed, and traffic-control personnel will be on site as needed.

<p><b>Traffic</b></p> <p>&gt; Travel in both directions will be maintained</p>	<p><b>Impacts/Interruptions</b></p> <p>&gt; Drivers may experience minor delays</p>
