Highway 99 – Intermittent Overnight Southbound Lane Closures

Updated March 18, 2026: The overnight closures will extend into April.

March – April 2026

As part of early construction works for the new toll-free, eight-lane tunnel to replace the existing George Massey Tunnel, intermittent southbound lane closures are scheduled along Highway 99 at the south tunnel portal throughout March **and April**. To minimize traffic impacts, work will take place overnight.

Closures will be limited to the curb lane, and travel in both directions will be maintained at all times.

Drivers are asked to follow signage and directions from traffic-control personnel.

What to Expect



Timing

- > Intermittent closures through March and **April** 2026



Hours of Work

- > Sunday night – Friday morning:
10 p.m. to 6 a.m.



Traffic

- > Southbound curb lane closures
- > Travel in both directions will be maintained
- > Watch for signage



Impacts/Interruptions

- > Minor delays
