This Daily Notification provides an update on the status of Preparatory Works Construction for the Fraser River Tunnel Project. Navigation Channel Status: Main Navigation Channel Open – No Restriction

Summary of Activities:

River Monitoring:

Today's activities include conducting ADCP/CTD transects near the existing George Massey Tunnel, refer to Figure 1. Marine equipment includes the TRIDEN-2 – Vessel MMSI (AIS) – 316058742 survey boat. The work area is in the main river channel. Transects will be performed at 3 locations as shown in Figure 1. At each location, 4 transect measurements will be conducted before moving to the next location.

Works will occur between **0400 hrs to 2200 hrs**
