

Fraser River Tunnel Project

Intermittent Stoppages on Millennium Trail

July 6, 2026

Early construction works for the new toll-free, eight-lane tunnel to replace the existing George Massey Tunnel are progressing. To ensure public safety during utility works, Millennium Trail users may experience brief, intermittent stoppages while crews are working in the Project area.

These stoppages will begin July 6 and continue for approximately one week, Monday to Saturday, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist trail users. The trail will remain open throughout this period, with short delays expected.

Upcoming Summer Trail Closure

Starting mid-July, a full closure of the section of Millenium Trail in the Project area will be required for the safety of trail users and construction crews. The trail will remain closed throughout the summer. More information will be provided in advance of the closure.
