Delta Site Preparation and Temporary Safety Closure of Millennium Trail

July 2026

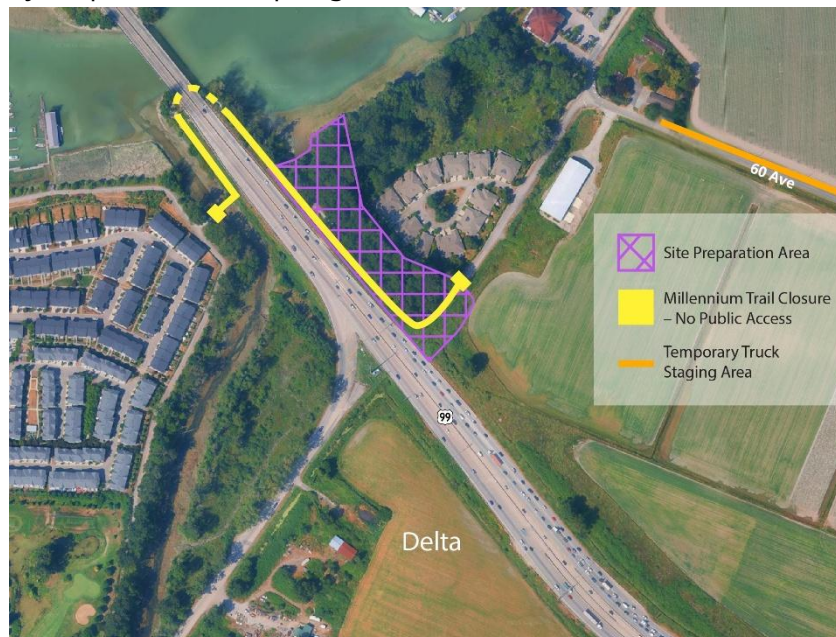
Early construction works for the new toll-free, eight-lane tunnel to replace the existing George Massey Tunnel are progressing. The following activities are required prior to construction of the temporary trestle bridge, which will provide crew access to and from Deas Island:

- Utility works
- Site development (excavation, grading & fill)
- Acoustic barrier installation

To complete this work, heavy equipment will operate within the purple-shaded area on the map below. To reduce idling near residences, a temporary staging area will be located on 60 Ave., indicated in orange on the map. Nearby residents can expect increased truck traffic on local roads.

To ensure public safety, **the 150-metre section of Millennium Trail identified in yellow on the map will be closed as early as the week of July 13, 2026**, and will remain closed through the summer due to active construction. Parking will be restricted near the Project area. Temporary fencing will be installed at both ends of the closure area.

	Timing > As early as the week of July 13, 2026 > The 24/7 trail closure will remain in place through the summer		Hours of Work > Monday – Saturday: Up to 24 hours a day > Occasional work on Sundays may be required > Where feasible, noisier activities will be scheduled during the day
	Pedestrian & Bicycle Traffic > Millennium Trail will be closed for 150m on either side of Hwy 99 > Trail users will not be able to cross Highway 99 at this juncture		Impacts/Interruptions > Noise and dust from heavy equipment (efforts will be made to limit impacts as much as possible) > When required, lights will be directed toward the Project site > Increased truck traffic on nearby roads and occasional truck staging on 60th Ave

Construction of the temporary trestle bridge is expected to begin in August. More information will be provided in advance.

Millennium Trail: Looking Forward

We recognize the trail's significance to the community and are working to maintain access whenever possible once the summer 2026 closure has concluded. To keep the trail open during construction, it may be re-aligned for periods and re-surfaced with temporary materials. When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to assist pedestrians and cyclists.
