Brief Description of Work:

Derrick Barge FRPD 'D.Reid' will be spudded down near the shoreline of Deas Island. Material scow barges, transporting pipe and sheet piles from the supplier (located in Mission B.C.) will be temporarily staged adjacent to the Derrick Barge periodically to facilitate the offloading of piles to the land based stockpile location, near the tunnel casting basin (Deas Island).

No navigation detours will be required for this activity as the barges will be located outside of the navigation channel.

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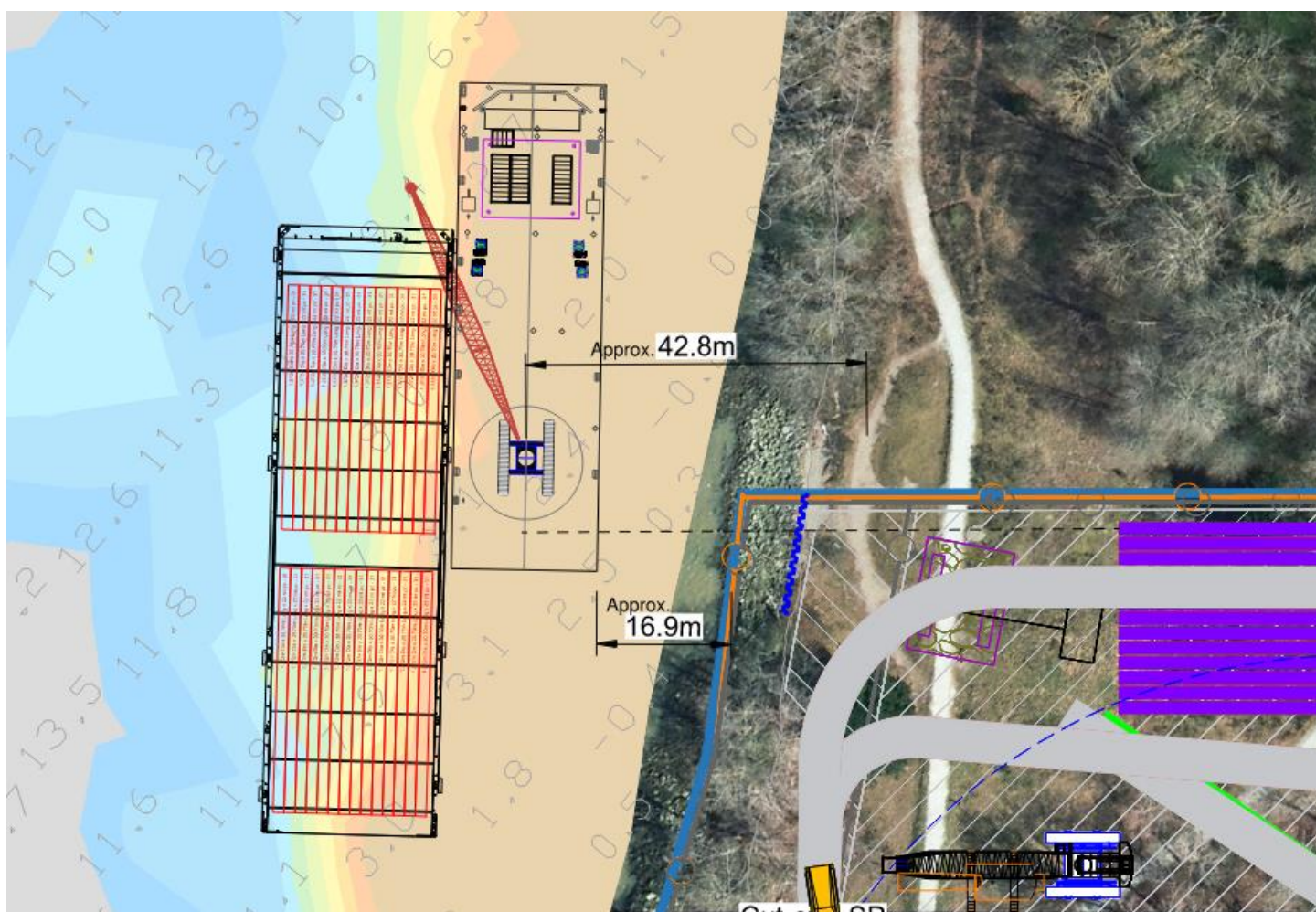


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Special Requests or Additional Information:

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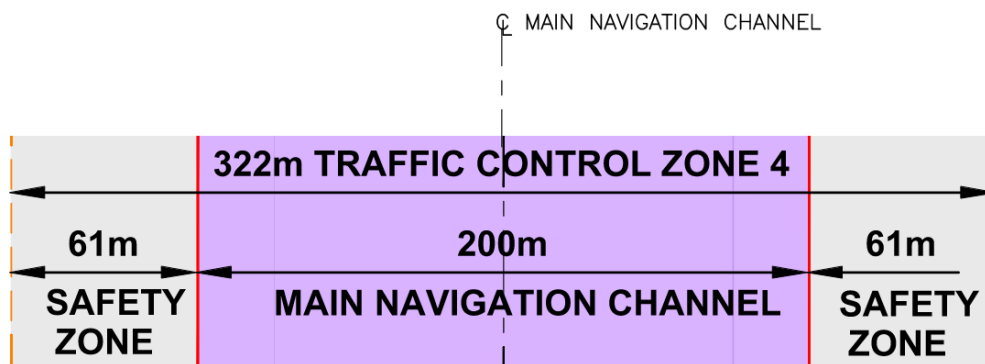
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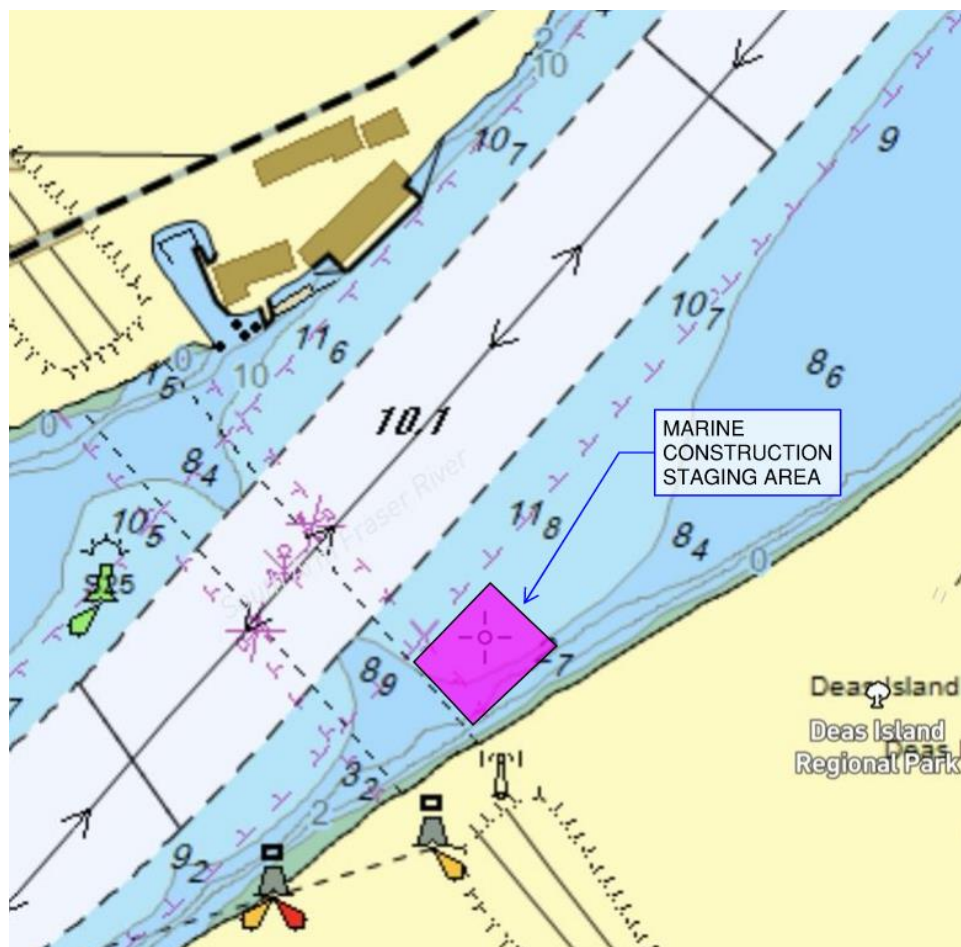


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EXISTING TRAFFIC CONTROL ZONE 4
