Navigation Channel Status: Main Navigation Channel Open – No Restriction

Summary of Activities:

Casting Basin Combi-Wall Material Offloading:

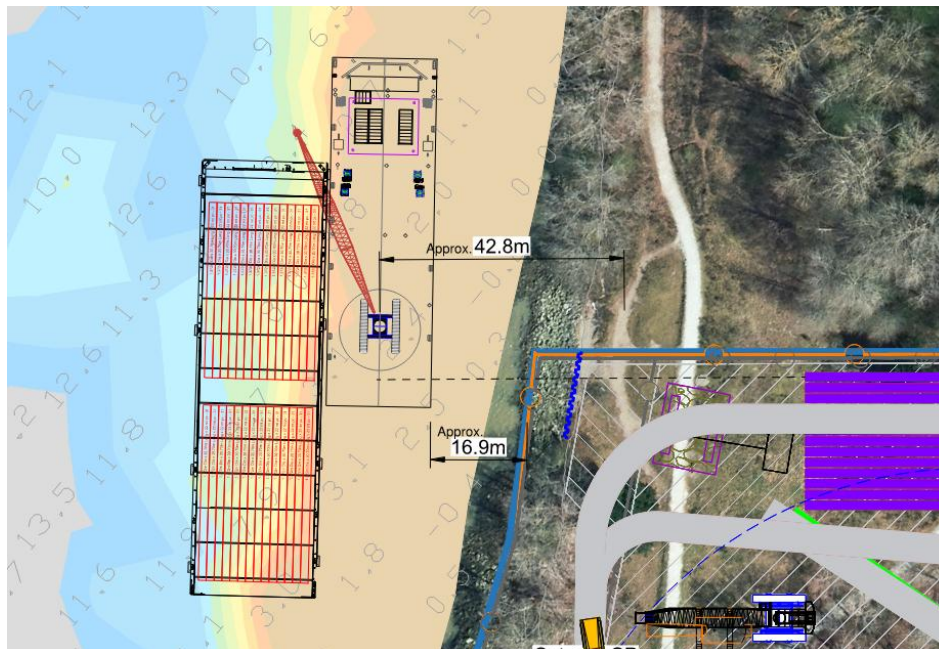


Figure 1: Marine Staging Equipment

Today's activities include marine equipment demobilizing from the construction staging area, near the shoreline of Deas Island, refer to Figure 1, and 2.

Marine equipment includes the D. Reid Marine Derrick – **Vessel MMSI (AIS) – 316058931**, and Ocean Hauler Material Barge 250' x 72' x 12' **OR** Ocean Carrier Material Barge 250' x 72' x 12'. The work area is within Fraser River, outside of the Main Navigation Channel.

Works will occur between **0700 hrs to 1900 hrs**. Barges may remain onsite outside of normal operating hours.

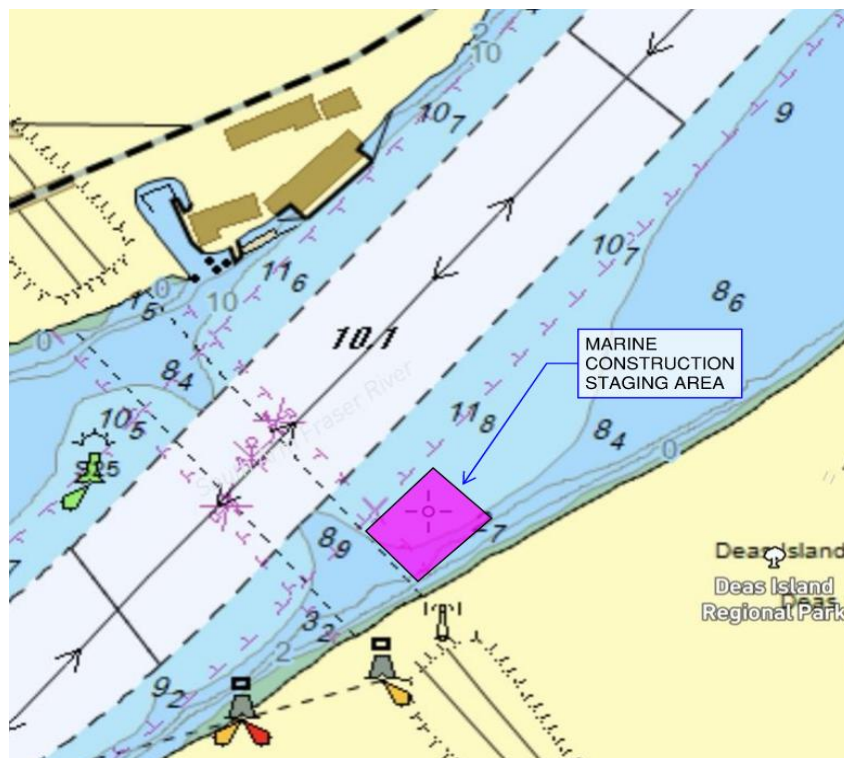


Figure 2: Marine Construction Staging Area

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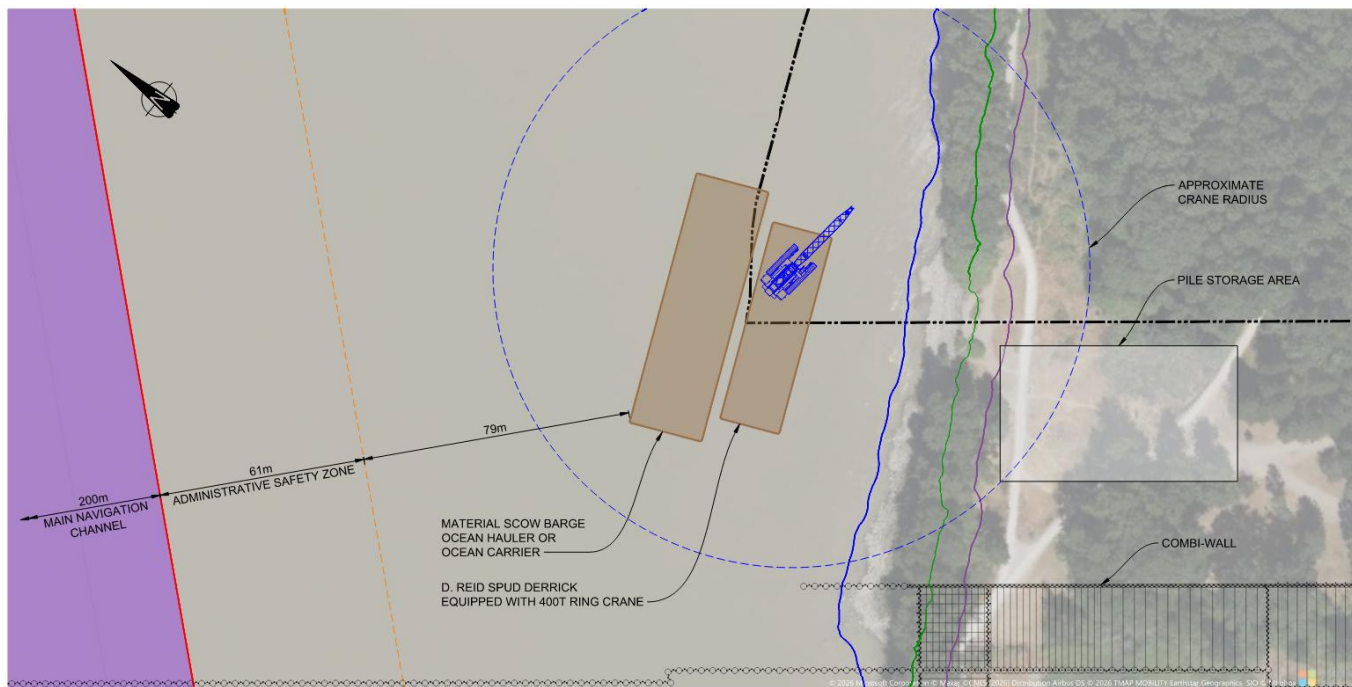


Figure 3: Marine Construction Staging Area

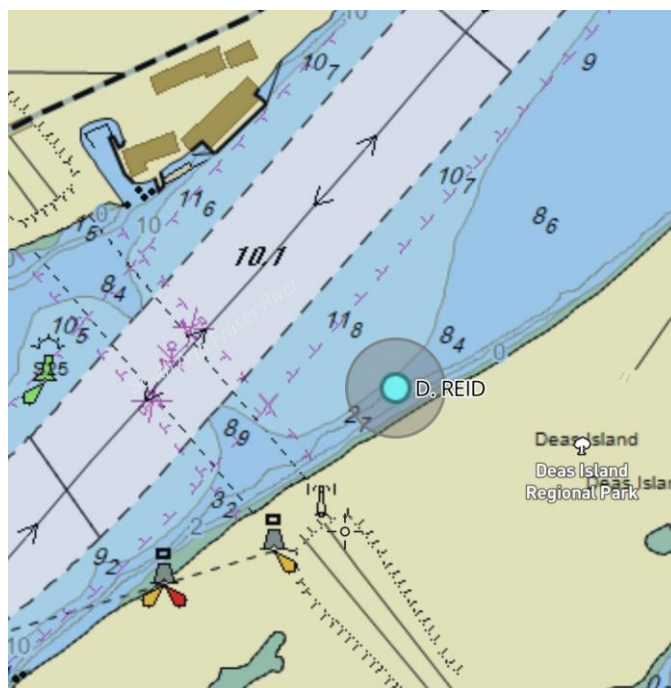


Figure 4: Marine Construction Equipment - D. Reid Marine Derrick - Location
