

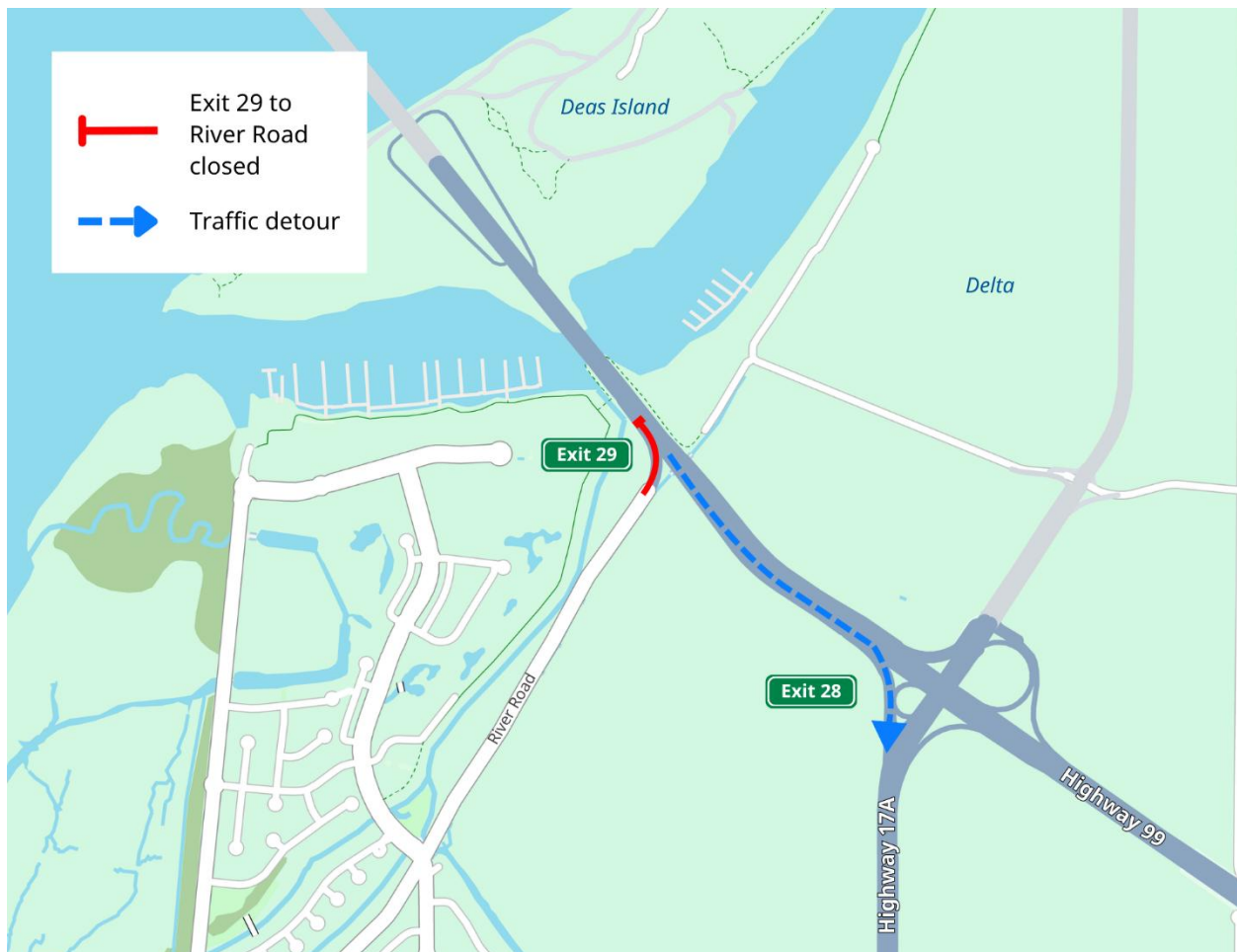
Fraser River Tunnel Project

Exit 29 to River Road Detour

September 2026

As part of preparatory construction work for the new toll-free, eight-lane tunnel to replace the existing George Massey Tunnel, Exit 29 to River Road will be closed from 11 p.m. to 1 p.m. starting as early as September 3 for approximately three weeks.

This closure is to safely conduct utility work. The detour route is via Exit 28. Drivers are asked to watch for signage indicating the detour route and follow directions from traffic-control personnel.
