This Daily Notification provides an update on the status of Preparatory Works Construction for the Fraser River Tunnel Project. Navigation Channel Status: Main Navigation Channel Open – No Restriction

Summary of Activities:

Marine Structure Demolition at Canfisco Site:

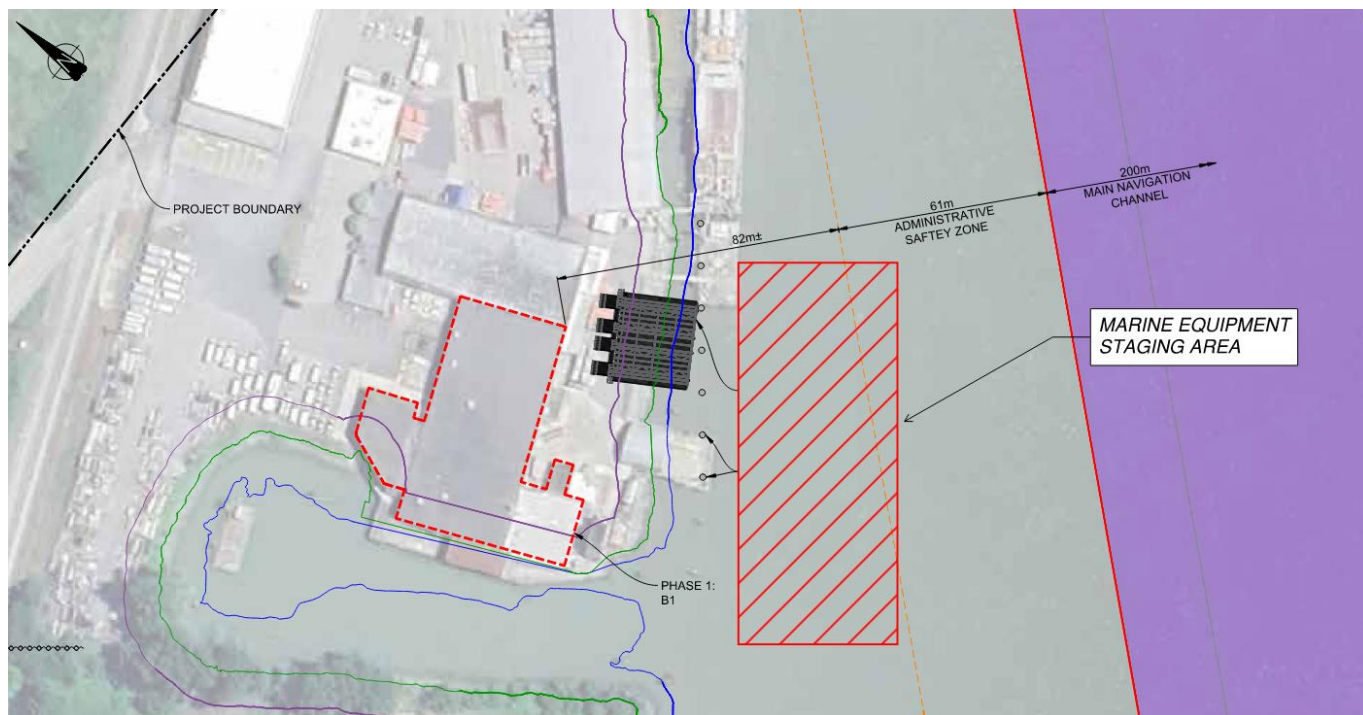


Figure 1: Marine Equipment Staging

Today's activities include marine equipment mobilizing to the construction staging area, near the shoreline of the Canfisco Property, refer to Figure 1.

Marine equipment includes the FRPD 'GE 2' Marine Derrick – **Vessel MMSI (AIS) 316058929**, and FRPD Perley (Or similar) Material Barge 164' x 48' **OR** MBD 32 (Or similar) Material Barge 120' x 40'. The work area is within Fraser River, outside of the Main Navigation Channel.

Works will occur between **0700 hrs to 1900 hrs**. Barges will remain onsite outside of normal operating hours.

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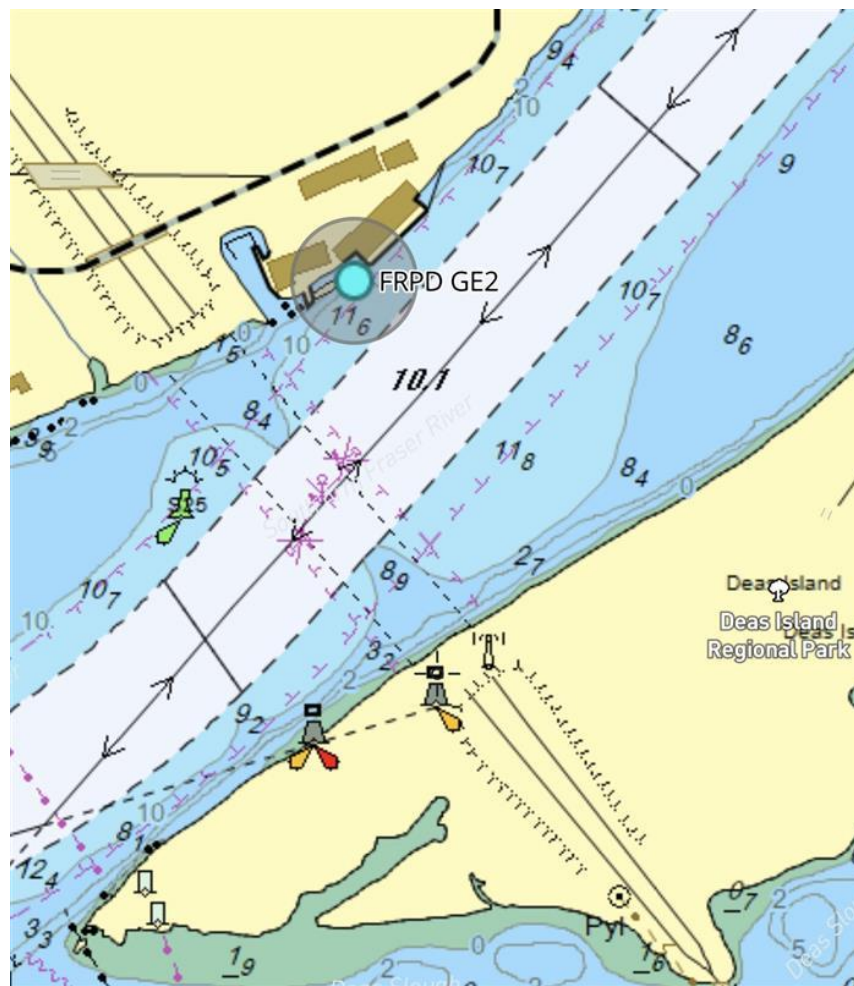


Figure 2: Marine Equipment Staging (Nautical Chart)
