Bike Shuttle: Richmond Pick-Up/Drop-Off Point Relocation Effective as of September 29, 2026.

September 2026

Updated September 11, 2026.

As part of preparatory construction work for the new toll-free, eight-lane tunnel to replace the existing George Massey Tunnel, the Richmond pick-up/drop-off location for the bike shuttle will be relocated on **September 29, 2026**. The change will accommodate construction work and help maintain safe operations along the Highway 99 corridor.

What to expect:

- **The Rice Mill Road stop will close after the final scheduled shuttle trip on the evening of September 28. The new Richmond shuttle stop will open at 6 a.m. on September 29 at the new location (see map below).**
- The new stop, indicated on the map below, will be located at the **Highway 99 southbound on-ramp at Steveston Highway**, providing a more direct connection to the trail network.
- The Delta pick-up/drop-off location will not change.
- There will be no impact to bike shuttle frequency or availability.
